

Keeping track of the grades you get in your course is easy!

You can get started by accessing the **Grades** menu.



It's important to know that every course sets up its grades differently, so this grades view is going to differ from course to course.

The best thing that you can do is to carefully read your **Course Introduction**. In every course, the grade structure will be clearly explained in the *Start Here! Course Information* section.



Using this example, we can focus in on some important information you will find common to all courses. First is the percentage column; here we can see the reported **Percentage** of 84.41% for the overall mark for this student.

There are also columns for the name of the **Grade item**, **Calculated weight**, **Percentage**, **Feedback** and **Contribution to course total**. If we look at this sample quiz, we can see the percentage is 74.19%, the raw grade is 46, and any feedback given by the teacher. You can use the *grade view* to identify assignments or quizzes that you would like to go back and review. Selecting the *Grade item* (first column) you would like to see.

One thing to remember when viewing your grades is that some grades *may* count toward your overall course mark, while others may not. You may encounter the words **Formative** and **Summative**. In short, formative tasks are meant to help you learn and provide practice, but they do not count for marks. Summative tasks measure your understanding - they DO count toward your course mark.
