

- Most ADLC courses have summative Final Exams. Many also have summative Mid-Term Exams. Exams are supervised evaluations that operate under standard rules of test invigilation and within specified time limits (unless a student has school approved special accommodations).
- Students registered with ADLC by an Alberta school partner will be supervised by that school in accordance with that school's policies and procedures. Circumstances (eg: student travel, summer course completion, distance learning, etc) may prevent students from writing in their registering school.
- In such cases, students will be required to make local arrangements for exam supervision and complete and [Exam Supervisor Form](#). Supervisor qualifications are listed on the form.
- Any expenses for exam supervision (transportation, proctoring fees, etc.) are borne by the student and/or their registering school.
