



Debriefing on the Use of Restraint/Seclusion

After each incident where there is use of seclusion and/or physical restraint, it is required that a debriefing session with all involved staff will occur and be documented within three days of the incident. The purpose of this debriefing session is to help determine the cause of the behaviour and what preventative actions could be implemented in the future to avoid the use of seclusion or physical restraint. When possible, appropriate expertise should be involved in the debriefing session.
